Design-Build Services for Union Station

Pursuant to the General Statutes of the State of North Carolina, sealed submissions are invited and shall be received by the City of Goldsboro at 200 North Center Street, Goldsboro, North Carolina, until 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, February 11, 2025.

The City of Goldsboro (COG) is soliciting statements of qualifications from construction-design teams interested in contracting for the construction of stabilization and rehabilitation work of the historic Union Station located at 100 N. Carolina Street, Goldsboro, NC. This project will address immediate stabilization needs identified by our local team, including members of NCDOT's Rail Division.
