- Will any Advanced Placement courses be reviewed? We are not reviewing any AP courses at this time, as we still have a few years left on those contracts.
- If selected, when will the first material be placed? And, how long are you looking to utilize adopted materials?

The New standard implementation will begin the 24-25 school year, and so we would need the first materials in classrooms before then. We have not determined our roll-out plan yet. We have not determined an end date but are looking to make our decision a long-term one.
