This project is for a waterline extension on Fairview Street in Kernersville, NC. The project includes the installation of approximately 506 linear feet of 6-inch ductile iron water line, as well as 280 linear feet of vitrified clay 8-inch sewer line. Work includes all tie-ins, pavement repair, erosion control and traffic control. The target start date is early to mid March 2026.

The M/WBE subcontracting goals for this project are **6% MBE** and **4% WBE** and must be met separately.
