

**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS**  
WINSTON-SALEM / FORSYTH COUNTY UTILITIES

Pursuant to N.C.G.S. 143-128 and 129, sealed bid proposals endorsed “**Lewisville Lift Station Upgrades, FB2633**” will be received by City/County Purchasing, 101 N. Main Street, Winston-Salem, NC 27101 until **3:00 pm, September 4, 2025**, at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud in City Hall Room 16. The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids. Should three bids not be received, the bid will be re-advertised.

Contractors must be properly licensed as required by Chapter 87 of the North Carolina General Statutes – at time of bid – to perform the work described herein as the general/prime contractor. Bid bond will be required at time of opening bids. Performance and Payment bonds will be required of the awarded contractor.

Scope of work includes the demolition of the existing lift station and installation of new one along with related work.

**NEW INFORMATION:** Funds are coming from the town of Lewisville. Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Utilities will be running the project. Budget is between \$4 and \$6 million. We are disclosing budget on this project due to the nature of expediency. This project must happen alongside a roadway project that is already running. We are rebidding due to rejecting all bids last time because they came in over budget.
