Introduction

Harnett County Schools (HCS) is soliciting Statements of Qualifications from qualified design consultants for professional services for the design of a metal structure containing a freezer/cooler with a specialized vented foundation. The structure is to be located adjacent to 1500 South Main Street, Lillington, NC 27546.

This solicitation is being conducted in accordance with the Mini-Brooks Act (N.C.G.S. §143-64.31), which requires that contracting for architectural, engineering, and other professional design services be based on demonstrated competence and qualification without regard to fee.

Scope of Services

- Design a metal building with an integrated freezer/cooler.
- Include a specialized vented foundation system in the plans.
- Provide stamped construction drawings prepared by a licensed professional.
- Submit all required design documents for review and approval.
- Collaborate with the selected general contractor during construction to ensure adherence to design specifications.

The scope may be adjusted as needed during project planning and coordination

Submittal Requirement

Interested firms shall submit a Statement of Qualifications (SOQ) that includes the following:

- Cover Letter (1 page)
- Firm Overview general background, size, office locations, services
- Relevant Experience summary of comparable project experience in NC
- Project Team résumés and roles of key personnel assigned.
- Description of similar projects completed within the last five years.

- References at least three (3) public sector clients for whom similar services were provided (preferred).
- Current workload and availability.
- Statement of understanding of project scope and schedule.

Submissions must not exceed 25 pages, excluding the cover letter.

Evaluation Criteria

Responses will be evaluated based on the following:

- Firm's experience with similar projects (30%)
- Project team qualification (25%)
- Understanding of the project and methodology (25%)
- Capacity to perform work within HCS's schedule (10%)
- References and past performance with public sector clients (10%)

Harnett County Schools reserves the right to select the firm that best meets its needs and may conduct interviews at its discretion.

Selection Process

This RFQ is the first step in a two-part selection process:

- 1. Qualifications-based selection: HCS will evaluate and rank firms based on submitted qualifications.
- 2. Fee negotiation: After ranking, HCS will negotiate a fair and reasonable fee with the topranked firm. If negotiations fail, HCS will proceed to the next-ranked firm.
