Question #15 – Can we burn vegetative clearing debris on site or in the alternative, can disposal fees be waived?

Response: Disposal fees cannot be waived. Burning the debris may be an option if the contractor is able to secure the appropriate permitting and burn in a manner that is safe and with consideration to any potential adverse impact to facility neighbors. Burn permitting is the responsibility of the contractor.

There are no bid alternates or write-ins allowed with this bid. Contractors are solely responsible for disposal of vegetative clearing debris as part of the project and should price line item B3 accordingly.
