## WIC Infant Formula Rebate

The NASPO ValuePoint Invitation for Bid (IFB) for WIC Infant Formula Rebate was released by the State of Kansas on June 13, 2024. The IFB number is **EVT0009507** and all vendor proposals must be submitted by 2:00 pm, Central Time, on **July 24, 2024**.

The purpose of this IFB is to establish one or more Master Agreements with manufacturers of Infant Formula to provide to the current WIC Alliance members, and in some cases achieve more favorable pricing, than is obtainable by an individual state or local government entity because of the collective volume of potential purchases by numerous state and local government entities.

The Master Agreement(s) resulting from this procurement may be used by state governments (including departments, agencies, institutions), institutions of higher education, political subdivisions (i.e., colleges, school districts, counties, cities, etc.), the District of Columbia, territories of the United States, and other eligible entities subject to approval of the individual chief procurement official and compliance with local statutory and regulatory provisions.
