PRE-BID MEETING:

A Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting was held virtually on December 17, 2024, at 2:00 pm, local time. A general review of the project was given, and the City reviewed the bidding requirements and the necessary documents required for bid packages. Additionally, questions submitted thus far were reviewed and answers were provided. The pre-bid meeting minutes and sign-in sheet are included with this addendum.

PRE-BID MEETING CLARIFICATIONS:

The Town of Wake Forest (TOWF) has confirmed that ARPA funds allocated for their portion of the project must be expended by 12/31/26. Therefore, construction of this work does not necessarily need to be sequenced to occur first; however, it is expected to take approximately 150 days to complete. The TOWF requests completion of their portion of the construction and submission of the associated pay application by 07/31/26, to ensure adequate time for reimbursement processing and approval.

CONTRACTOR QUESTIONS THROUGH 12/19/24:

1. Question: Will the engineer's estimated construction cost be shared?

Answer:The City has confirmed that sharing this information is acceptable. The
engineer's estimated construction cost is as follows:
Total Base Bid Price:\$13.1M
Total Bid Alt. 1 Price:\$144.5K
Total Bid Price:\$13.25M
These numbers represent WK Dickson's best judgement, with the aim of being
in the middle for where the project bid prices come in at.

2. Question: What is the anticipated NTP for this project?

Answer: NTP is anticipated around April 18, 2025.

3. Question: What is the latest date the project can start?

Answer: The Owner desires for the project to start as soon as NTP is issued.

4. Question: Is the owner open to extending the bid date to accommodate for the upcoming holidays?

Answer: After the pre-bid meeting, the design engineer and the Owner re-reviewed this request. It is felt that prospective bidders have sufficient time to assemble bids. The upcoming holidays were considered when the bid opening date was determined, which is why there are twenty-eight (28) weekdays between the bid-advertisement and bid-opening dates.

5. Question: Is bid item #159, Right of Entry Acquisition with the City of Raleigh and Property Owners, referring to easement acquisitions?

Answer: The unit price language associated with this bid line item can be found in Specification 01 22 00, section 1.05.D.31. No, this does not pertain to easement acquisitions. This is a contingency item intended to cover situations where the contractor requires access to private property to complete the work. It is meant to account for the time and coordination needed with property owners and the City of Raleigh.

2. Project Overview

- **a.** Raleigh Water intends to perform improvements to the water and wastewater infrastructure within the Town of Wake Forest (TOWF). Additionally, this project will involve enhancements to TOWF stormwater infrastructure and streets.
 - i. Within Section 00410, Bid Form, prospective bidders should examine the Bid Schedule for a complete list of items anticipated for the project, as well as Article 5.01.B.1. for the Bid Alternate #1 description. Prospective bidders should also examine the construction plan set released for bidding.
- b. For construction of the items that the TOWF owns, the Town and the City of Raleigh have established an Interlocal Agreement. The contract will be managed by Raleigh Water and pay applications shall be submitted to Raleigh Water for payment. Raleigh Water will review the pay applications and seek input from TOWF where applicable.

3. General Project Considerations

- **a.** The Contractor will need to coordinate with the following, including, but not limited to:
 - i. NCDOT, Century Link, PSNC Energy, Level 3 communications, Ting Internet, Duke Energy, TOWF power / engineering / arborist / Public works / Fire / Communications, and Raleigh Water.
- b. Staging and lay down areas:
 - i. One (1) staging, stockpiling, and laydown area has been included in the plans (see sheet G11). This location, 214 S. College St, is owned by TOWF and has been approved for use by NCDEQ and TOWF. There is an existing concrete driveway apron for entrance and exit located on S. College St. The area designated is clear and open.
 - **ii.** In general, the Contractor is responsible for securing all staging and lay down areas and obtaining all necessary approvals for the use of those areas including an erosion and sedimentation control permit. No separate payment shall be made.
 - 1) These areas should be located at least 50-ft away from storm drain inlets, temporary diversion, channels, basins, and surface water bodies per NCDEQ regulation.
- **c.** An excavation plan shall be prepared in accordance with the project specifications and shall be submitted and approved by NCDOT prior to performing any excavation within NCDOT right-of-way.
- **d.** Prospective bidders should review the Project Manual Appendices for project permits, available geotechnical report information, and the City Right-of-Entry Agreement Template.







4. Contract Time

- a. Prospective bidder's should examine Section 00410, Bid Form, Article 6 for the Contract Time of Completion, Milestone Events, and Liquidated damages amounts.
- **b.** The City anticipates executing a Contract with the selected low-bid Contractor sometime towards the middle of March, 2025.
- c. The City anticipates issuing the selected low-bid Contractor the construction NTP sometime around April 18, 2025.
- d. The TOWF is using funding for their portion of the project, which is storm water replacement and paving of N. & S. Allen Road. These funds need to be spent by 12/31/26. Therefore, the Contractor will need to sequence this work to come first during construction to allow enough time for submission of the reimbursement request as well as approval / completion of it. The TOWF related work is anticipated to take approximately 150 days to construct. If NTP is provided on April 18, 2025, this means having the work completed around September 15, 2025.

5. MWBE Participation Requirements

- a. The City has a goal to contract or sub-contract 15% of the contract amount to certified MWBE's for this project.
- **b.** Prospective bidders should refer to Specification 00440 for the MWBE forms and affidavits.

- d. Input from P. Adderlev:
 - i. The Prime bidder will submit either Affidavit A, or Affidavit B. The prime bidder will only submit Affidavit B if the prime bidder plans to complete the work with their own workforce. Affidavit A is the good faith efforts document.
 - 1) If the prime bidder works through the checklist on Affidavit A, they will need to contact an agency to work with. If the prime bidder is not aware of these agencies, they may reach out to P. Adderlev for help.
 - 2) If the prime bidder makes any good faith effort, they should maintain the documentation in case the goal is not met. The selected low-bid prime bidder will need to submit that information.
 - ii. While the City of Raleigh is not a certifying body, the City does recognize HUB and DBE certifications from NCDOA HUB and NCDOT DBE programs.
 - 1) If you plan to work with an MWBE that is not certified, you may do so, but that participation won't count towards the 15%. However, if at any time during the life of the project, that firm becomes HUB or DBE certified, credit for that participation will be recognized.

6. Submitting Complete & Accurate Proposals

- b. Only registered plan holders that have attended this mandatory pre-bid meeting may bid as the Prime General Contractor.
 - i. Plans are available for purchase by going to the Plan Room at www.wkdicksonplanroom.com. Neither Owner nor Engineer shall be responsible for copies of the Bidding Documents obtained from other sources.
- **c.** Unit Prices shall be provided in figures for all pay items and all schedules of work.
- d. Bids shall be subject to acceptance for 120 days after bid opening. (Specification 00410, Article 2)
