A non-Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting will be held at the location listed above.

Sealed Bids <u>must be hand delivered to Brasfield & Gorrie</u> to the designated bid opening location and no later than the time listed above or mailed to Brasfield & Gorrie's Raleigh office for receipt on the date prior to the bid date.
