Past performance on similar projects3. Adequate staff and proposed design or consultant team for the project4. Current workload5. Proposed design approach for the project including design team and consultants6. Recent experience with project costs and schedules7. Construction administration capabilities8. Proximity to and familiarity with the area where project is located9. Record of successfully completed projects without major legal or technical problems10. Other factors which may be appropriate for the project <p>Please submit three (3) copies of current SF 254 Form with the required letters of interest and the information packet. In the interest of cost-savings to the designers, consistency of the submittals and more efficient use of time with the selection process, the submitted information package should not include notebooks, binders, clips, etc. The format should be 8.5" x 11" pages stapled in the upper left-hand corner. The package length should not exceed ten (10) pages plus the SF 254 Form and letter of interest.</p>
