Addendum I contain Questions 01 – 7 for this Invitation to Bid. The following is a collection of questions submitted for clarification regarding RFP 163-05212024TB – Food Contact Paper & Plastics. All questions submitted regarding this RFP have been answered to the best of our ability.

- 1) Can you confirm CMS S/N #21081, 21085, & 21089 estimated quantities? I plan to bid HOSGLL116, which is packaged in 120 pairs per case. On line #21081 where the estimated quantity is 1200, is this 1200 pair? Equating to 10 cases?
A. This is correct 1200 pairs equate to 10 Cases.
- 2) Based on previous ordering history and purchase orders, about how often are the gloves ordered (Monthly, quarterly or other) and what is an approximate box order?
