Separate sealed bids for the demolition/clearance of four (4) houses and the provision/set-up of four (4) State Building Code modular houses will be received in the Board Room at the Ferd L. Harrison Municipal Offices, 1310 Main Street, Scotland Neck, NC on Tuesday, November 19, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. for 4 demolition & clearance and 11:00 a.m. for 4 State Building Code modular houses, then be publicly opened and read aloud. Proposals may be submitted to the Town Clerk's office, 1310 Main Street, P. O. Box 537, Scotland Neck, NC 27874 prior to the Bid Opening.

The Town has received \$664,700 in a federal 2019 CDBG-NR grant representing 100% of total project costs to undertake housing clearance, reconstruction (replacement on site) and rehabilitation activities. All federal CDBG requirements will apply to the contract: Bidders on this work will be required to comply with Section 109 and E.O. 11246 which prohibits discrimination in employment regarding race, creed, color, sex, or national origin. Bidders must comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Anti-Kickback Act, E-Verify Regulations, and Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act. The Town is committed to and supportive of efforts to effectively maintain and/or increase the use of Small and Minority/Women-Owned Business and Historically Underutilized Businesses (HUB) contract participation for construction projects, services (including professional and consulting services) and commodities purchases; **AND** increase contract participation to offer employment, training and contracting opportunities to low and very low-income persons in the Town in accordance with Section 3 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968, as amended. Small, minority, and/or women owned, Historically Underutilized Businesses (HUB), and Section 3 businesses are encouraged to submit bids. The Town supports and encourages support of the Fair Housing Act which prohibits discrimination in housing based on race, color, national origin, religion, sex, family status, and disability.

Bidders may not be debarred from receiving state or federal contracts. The Town reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids.
