Pursuant to the City of Asheville's Procurement, Purchasing and Contracting Policy, Bids will be received by the City of Asheville for the following:

Description of Bid:

The City of Asheville is requesting proposals from qualified, licensed landscape contractors with deep horticultural knowledge to successfully maintain heavily used turf areas on parks and recreational facilities. Parks to be included in the bid are as follows in the Exhibit A section below.

- Correct horticultural practices for keeping the turf areas mowed at the proper height.
- Edging sidewalks adjacent to the turf areas and string trimming areas not reachable by mowing equipment.
- Blowing clippings from turf areas after mowing and also removing clippings from sidewalks or mulched areas.
- Leaf collection and removal from turf and natural areas.
