1.1 PROJECT INFORMATION

- A. Notice to Bidders: **Qualified** bidders may submit bids for project as described in this Document. Submit bids according to the Instructions to Bidders.
 - 1. Regulatory Requirements: Wayne County shall govern submittal, opening, and award of bids.
- B. Project Identification: Genoa Gravity Sewer Rehabilitation - Phase I
 - 1. Project Location: Goldsboro, North Carolina.
- C. Owner: Wayne County.

- E. Project Description: Project consists of the following:
 - 1. Rehabilitation of approximately 4,750 LF of 6-18-inch gravity main via CIPP.
 - 2. Relocation of approximately 610 LF of 8-inch gravity main via open cut.
 - 3. Rehabilitation of 19 manholes.
 - 4. Replacement of 3 manholes.
 - 5. Genoa PS: Replacement of upper slide rail brackets and generator like-for-like. Installation of fall protection grating. Replacement of influent bar screen with new grinder.
 - 6. Landfill PS: Installation of vent pipe on wet well and fall protection grating.
 - 7. Grantham Middle and Grantham Elementary PSs: Installation of bypass connections.
 - 8. Highway 117 PS: Installation of flow meter.
 - 9. Project cost range is anticipated between \$2,100,000 and \$3,150,000.
- F. Construction Contract: Bids will be received for the following Work:
 - 1. General Contract (all trades).

1.2 BID SUBMITTAL AND OPENING

- A. Owner will receive sealed bids until the bid time and date at the location given below. Owner will consider bids prepared in compliance with the Instructions to Bidders issued by Owner, and delivered as follows:

- B. Bids will be thereafter publicly opened and read aloud.

1.3 BID SECURITY

- A. Bid security shall be submitted with each bid in the amount of **5** percent of the bid amount. No bids may be withdrawn for a period of 60 days after opening of bids. Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive informalities and irregularities.

1.4 PREBID MEETING

- A. Prebid Meeting: A Prebid meeting for all bidders will be held at the Wayne County Courthouse Board of Commissioners Meeting Room, 224 E Walnut Street, 4th floor, Goldsboro, NC 27530 on September 24, 2026 at 11:00 a.m. Prospective prime bidders are required to attend.
 - 1. Bidders' Questions: Engineer will provide responses at Prebid conference to bidders' questions received up to **two** business days prior to conference.
 - 2. General contractors are required to attend in person.

- B. With each request for Bidding Documents, supply the following information: Company name, contact person, street address, phone number, and email address for Bidding point of contact; NC contractor's license with limitation and classification; indicate if the firm will be a Prime bidder, Supplier or Sub-Contractor. Neither the County nor the Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bid Documents including any addendum obtained from any other source.

1.6 TIME OF COMPLETION AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

- A. Successful bidder shall begin the Work on receipt of the Notice to Proceed and shall complete the Work within the Contract Time. **Work is subject to liquidated damages.**

1.7 BIDDER'S QUALIFICATIONS

- A. Bidders must be properly licensed under the laws governing their respective trades and be able to obtain insurance and bonds required for the Work. **A Performance Bond, separate Labor and Material Payment Bond, and Insurance in a form acceptable to Owner will be required of the successful Bidder.**
