

Advertisement for Bids (Formal - N.C.G.S. 143-129)

Pursuant to North Carolina General Statute 143-129, sealed bids will be received by the City of Asheville Purchasing Division until 3:00pm on March 14, 2024, and be immediately opened and read aloud for the project described as follows:

Description of Work:

The project includes, but is not limited to:

1. A new 8.9 million gallon (MG) High-Density Polyethylene (HDPE) lined earthen raw water reserve,
2. A new HDPE earthen sludge lagoon,
3. A new 1.0 MG pre-stressed concrete clear well,
4. Replacement of four rapid mixer and eighteen flocculators in the treatment modules,
5. Replacement of three centrifugal intake pumps,
6. Replacement of 60"x60" wall mounted slide gate at intake structure,
7. Replacement of two vertical turbine raw water pumps, plus installation of a third vertical turbine raw water pump and variable frequency drive (VFD),
8. Replacement of three centrifugal transfer pumps and VFDs,
9. Replacement of three filter consoles with new consoles with touch screen OITs
10. Replacement of three vertical turbine finished water pumps and VFDs,
11. Replacement of polyester baffle curtains and associated hardware in 0.5 MG steel clear well,
12. Replacement of two caustic bulk storage tanks, and one fluoride bulk storage tank, including miscellaneous concrete repairs and installation of chemical coating on bulk tank concrete floors and containment wall,
13. Installation of one orthophosphate bulk storage tank and associated piping, including miscellaneous concrete repairs and installation of chemical coating on concrete floors and containment wall,
14. Replacement of chemical metering pumps for zinc orthophosphate (2), fluoride (2), caustic (5), sodium hypochlorite (5), and alum (3),
15. Miscellaneous lighting upgrades,
16. Electrical switchgear replacement,
17. SCADA programming changes to incorporate above plant modifications.
18. And other Work indicated in the Contract Documents.

Standard of Award:

The award of the Contract will be made to the lowest responsible, responsive bidder, who, in the opinion of the City, is qualified to perform the work required and is responsible and reliable. When Alternate Bid items are required in the Bid, the Contract will be awarded to that responsible Bidder whose Bid for the Alternate or combination of Alternates, selected by the City, is the lowest.

- **Asheville Business Inclusion Policy:** The City of Asheville has adopted the Asheville Business Inclusion Policy to encourage women and minority businesses' participation in the public bidding

process. The purpose of this outreach effort is to increase the likelihood of availability and utilization of MWBEs in the award of contracts. It is the Policy of the City to (1) provide minorities and women an equal opportunity to participate in all aspects of its contracting and procurement programs and (2) to prohibit any and all discrimination against persons or businesses in pursuit of these opportunities.

Drug Free Workplace: The City of Asheville is a drug-free workplace employer. By submitting this bid, the prospective contractor certifies that if awarded the contract, they and their subcontractors shall comply with the following: The City requires contractors/vendors entering into a contract with the City to provide a drug-free workplace in the performance of said contract. The contractor, upon execution of the contract, certifies that it will provide a drug-free workplace during the performance of the work on this contract. License Requirements:

All bidders must have current North Carolina General Contractor licenses with the appropriate classification for all work of the project at the time of the bid.

Bid Submittals:

The City has prepared this Advertisement for Bids which identifies the services to be undertaken.

In order to be considered, all bids must be submitted in writing no later than the bid due date, at which time bids will be opened and read aloud. Contractors mailing bid packages should allow delivery time to ensure timely receipt of their bid. The responsibility for getting their bid to the City of Asheville on or

before the specified time and date is solely and strictly the responsibility of the proposing contractor. The City will in no way be responsible for delays caused by any occurrence.

Miscellaneous Requirements of the Bid:

- All bids must be submitted on the form of Bid Proposal provided.
- All bidders are required to submit cash, a cashier's check, or certified check in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the bid proposal. In lieu of said money, the bidder can submit a bid bond executed by a corporate surety licensed in North Carolina to execute said bonds. This deposit shall be retained be retained if the lowest responsible bidder failed to execute the contract within

ten (10) days of the award or fails to give satisfactory surety as required in North Carolina General Statutes Section 143-129.

- All bids and bid bonds shall be sealed in two (2) separate envelopes and shall not be opened prior to the time set for the bid opening.
- Until bid opening time, the City may return the bid to the bidder for modification or change-out of bid.
- No bid may be withdrawn after bids have been opened, except as provided in North Carolina General Statutes Section 143-129.1.
- The successful bidder will be required to furnish a performance bond and a payment bond in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amount. Those bonds shall meet the requirements of North Carolina General Statutes Section 143-129 and of Article 3 of Chapter 44A of the North Carolina General Statutes.

The City of Asheville reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive informalities.

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
