I. The Department responses to questions received are below.

- 1. Section 5.1 section A of the SOW stats that the vender must maintain permits for incineration of Medical Waste. Is the vender required to be a TSDF for this bid? Or will it be adequate for the Vender to ship the material to a TSDF for disposal?

Department Response: The vendor is not required to be a TSDF for this bid. They are required to ship the material to a TSDF for disposal.

- 2. Is there a main central storage location at each facility for pick up?

Department Response: Each facility has a designated storage location.

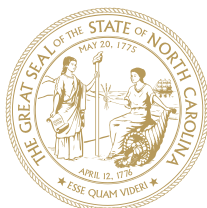
- 3. Section 5.1 section B of the SOW stats that "Vendor shall provide the quantity of containers within 30 days of contract startup" Are you stating that the vender must supply all of the containers for Bio-Hazardous and Hazardous materials at the start of the contract?

Department Response: Yes.

And if so what is the total amount of containers the vender must supply?

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At the start of the contract each facility would need an initial supply of containers (quantity per facility would vary based on mission and population). Refer to Section 5.1, B., 2., and Attachment H: Regulated Medical Waste Locations and Frequencies.

4. Are the hazardous drugs being separated by P, U, and D listed waste?

Department Response: No

5. What are the Drugs specifically are you wanting to depose of?

Department Response: NIOSH List Hazardous drugs and containers along with gloves, masks, and gowns worn while handling hazardous drugs.

6. Will there be a onsite personal who is trained to sign a Hazardous Waste Manifest at each location?

Department Response: Yes per Policy and Procedure
