Bidders not in compliance with this provision may be disqualified, at the option of the County, from the contract award. - 20. <u>TRANSPORTATION CHARGES</u>: FOB Destination. Shipping and handling charges must be included in the price of stated on the bid form and not listed as a separate item.

21. <u>PROTEST PROCEDURES</u>: Any party which is a prospective bidder or offeror may be aggrieved by the solicitation must submit a written protest within five (5) calendar days prior to the opening of the Invitation for Bid.

Any party which is an actual bidder, offeror, or contractor that may be aggrieved by the award of a contract, must submit a written protest within five (5) days of County transmitting the announcement of intent to award.

The protest must be addressed to the office of the Onslow County Purchasing Division Head and must include all the following information: 1) name, address, telephone number, facsimile number and e-mail of the protester; 2) signature of the protester or authorized agent; 3) the bid name and bid number; 4) a detailed statement of the legal and factual grounds of protest including copies of relevant documents; 5) any supporting exhibits, evidence, or documents to substantiate any claims; 6) all information establishing that the protester is an interested party for the purpose of filing a protest; and 7) the form of relief requested.

After careful consideration of all relevant information, and consultation with the County Attorney, the Purchasing Division Head shall make a written decision. A decision of the Purchasing Division Head may be appealed to the Finance Officer. This appeal must be in writing and be delivered to the office of the Finance Officer within seven (7) calendar days of the date of the Purchasing Division Head faxed or emailed the decision.

The Finance Officer will then have seven (7) calendar days to render a decision. This decision may be appealed to the County Manager within seven (7) calendar days of the date of the Finance Officer faxed or emailed decision. The County Manger will then have seven (7) days to render a final decision. Any and all costs incurred by a protesting party in connection with a protest shall be the sole responsibility of the protesting party.

- 22. <u>E-VERIFY</u>. As a condition of payment for services rendered under this agreement, Offeror shall comply with the requirements of Article 2 of Chapter 64 of the General Statutes. SPECIFICATIONS FOR CAB AND CHASSIS WITH STEEL DUMP BODY

PART I

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. The equipment furnished under these specifications shall be a new 2022-2024 year model as offered to commercial trade, and shall be of quality workmanship and material. The bidder represents that all equipment offered under this specification shall be new.
- 2. Bidder should submit with the bid, the latest printed literature, and detailed specifications on equipment the bidder proposes to furnish. This literature is for informational purposes only.
- 3. The unit shall be completely assembled and adjusted, and all equipment including standard and supplemental equipment shall be installed and the unit made ready for continuous operation.
- 4. All parts not specifically mentioned which are necessary for the unit to be complete and ready for operation or which are normally furnished as standard equipment shall be furnished by the vendor. All parts shall conform in strength, quality, and workmanship to the accepted standards of the industry.
- 5. The unit provided shall meet or exceed all Federal and State of North Carolina safety, health, lighting and noise regulations and standards in effect and applicable to equipment furnished at the time of manufacture.
- 6. The equipment shall be FOB to the Onslow County Vehicle Maintenance Facility located at 411 Meadowview Road, Jacksonville, NC 28540 for acceptance inspection.
- 7. The equipment shall be titled to Onslow County, 234 NW Corridor Blvd, Jacksonville, NC 28540.
- 8. The vendor shall furnish Manufacturer's Statement of Origin (MSO) for each unit. MSO shall be executed in the name of Onslow County and hand delivered or mailed to: Onslow County Purchasing, 234 NW Corridor Blvd, Jacksonville, NC 28540. Onslow County will not accept a unit and process payment until acceptance check has been performed and the MSO received.

PART II SPECIFICATIONS

1. <u>SCOPE</u>: It is the intent of this specification to describe a vehicle chassis to be equipped with a five (5) to seven (7) cubic yard dump body with a three (3) man cab. The chassis including all necessary equipment shall be furnished and delivered new, complete, and ready for use. All parts not specifically mentioned but which are necessary for the complete unit shall be supplied and installed by the vendor even though such work or material are not specifically outlined and shall conform in strength, quality of material and workmanship to the best practice known to the automobile industry.

2. **<u>GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT RATING (GVWR)</u>**: GVWR shall be a minimum of 30,000 pounds.

- 3. <u>**CHASSIS:**</u> Chassis, components, and accessories (including after-market/non-OEM upfits) shall comply with The Maintenance Council (TMC) recommended practices.
 - a. The effective cab-to-axle dimension shall be in accordance with the manufacturer's specifications for the equipment offered.
 - b. Frame shall be in accordance with the manufacturer's specifications for the equipment offered with frame reinforcement.

 - r. Front tow hooks
 - s. Radiator protector/stone guard shall be provided, or integral with, the front grille.
- 5. **<u>STEERING</u>**: Truck shall be equipped with power steering of type normally recommended by manufacturer.

- 6. <u>**CAB**</u>: The truck shall have one cab constructed with two (2) doors, entry for three (3) men capacity of steel, aluminum or fiberglass with a hood and fender unit of conventional design. Unit shall be equipped with a grille. Truck shall also be equipped with, but not limited to the following:

- 14. **<u>PARTS AND SERVICE</u>**: The manufacturer of the equipment furnished shall have an authorized dealer within the state of North Carolina. The authorized dealer shall have factory-trained personnel available for warranty repairs and the performance of service.
- 15. <u>MANUFACTURER'S STATEMENT OF ORIGIN (MSO)</u>: Vendor shall furnish MSO for each unit. MSO shall be executed in the name of Onslow County 234 NW Corridor Blvd, Jacksonville, NC 28540. The County of Onslow will not accept a unit and process payment without the MSO.
- 16. **WARRANTY:** The unit of equipment shall be warranted against defects in material and workmanship for a minimum of thirty-six (36) months or 36,000 miles. If the manufacturer's standard warranty exceeds twelve (12) months, then the standard warranty period shall be in effect. A copy of the manufacturer's standard warranty shall be submitted with the bid proposal.
- 17. **<u>DATA SHEET</u>**: The attached data sheets should be completed and submitted in duplicate for informational purposes only.

PART III

SPECIFICATIONS FOR DUMP BODY

1. SCOPE: This specification describes a dump body for use by the County of Onslow mounted on the cab and chassis as described in Part II of this Invitation to Bid. The vendor shall supply and mount the body in accordance with the manufacturer's specifications.

The body shall be designed and built with quality materials and workmanship and to meet practically every tandem application for strength and long dependable service.

GENERAL: The body shall be designed to meet the minimum requirements:

- a. Capacity: 5-7 Cubic Yards
- b. 24-inch Side Walls or Industry Standard
- c. Width (in accordance with manufacturer's specifications)
- d. Materials: Shall be a steel body with the floor steel plate one piece. The body shall be standard reinforced cross-members and long members.

- e. 50" Headboard with Window
- f. 2 Piece Barn Door
- g. GS6620 P22-8C Scissor Hoist (Twin Cylinder) or compatible system

- 2. **<u>PAYMENT</u>**: Payment will be made within Net thirty (30) days after the acceptance inspection has been completed and Onslow County determines that the equipment delivered meets specifications or the day on which a correct invoice is received, whichever is later.

3. **WORKING DAY:** A working day is defined as a calendar day, not including Saturdays, Sundays, or regularly observed state and federal holidays.

GENERAL CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. <u>GOVERNMENTAL RESTRICTIONS</u>: In the event any Governmental restrictions are imposed which necessitate alteration of the material, quality, workmanship, or performance of the items offered prior to their delivery, it shall be the responsibility of the Offeror to notify in writing Onslow County at once, indicating the specific regulation which required such alterations. Onslow County reserves the right to accept any such alterations, including any price adjustments occasioned thereby, or to cancel the contract.
- 2. <u>AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS</u>: Any and all payments to the Offeror are dependent upon and subject to the availability of funds to the County for the purposes set forth in this agreement.
- 3. <u>TAXES</u>: Any applicable taxes shall be invoiced as a separate item.
- 4. <u>SITUS</u>: The place of this contract, its situs and forum, shall be North Carolina, where all matters, whether sounding in contract or tort, relating to its validity, construction, interpretation, and enforcement shall be determined.
- 5. <u>GOVERNING LAW</u>: This contract is made under and shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of North Carolina.
- 6. <u>PAYMENT TERMS</u>: Payment terms are Net not later than 30 days after receipt of correct invoice or acceptance of goods, whichever is later. The using agency is responsible for all payments to the contractor under the contract. Payment may be made by procurement card, and it shall be accepted by the contractor for payment if the contractor accepts that card (Visa, Mastercard, etc.) from other customers. If payment is made by procurement card, then payment may be processed immediately by the contractor.
- 7. <u>CONDITION AND PACKAGING</u>: Unless otherwise provided by special terms and conditions or specifications, it is understood and agreed that any item offered or shipped has not been sold or used for any purpose and shall be in first class condition. All containers/packaging shall be suitable for handling, storage, or shipment.
- 8. <u>AFFIRMATIVE ACTION</u>: The contractor will take affirmative action in complying with all Federal and State requirements concerning fair employment and employment of people with disabilities and concerning the treatment of all employees without regard to discrimination by reason of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, or disability.
- **9.** <u>STANDARDS</u>: All manufactured items and/or fabricated assemblies subject to operation under pressure, operation by connection to an electric source, or operation involving a connection to a manufactured, natural, or LP gas source shall be constructed and approved in a manner acceptable to the appropriate county/state inspector which customarily requires the label or re-examination listing or identification marking of the appropriate safety standard organization; such as the American Society of Mechanical Engineers for pressure vessels;

The Underwriters Laboratories and/or National Electrical Manufacturers' Association for electrically operated assemblies; or the American Gas Association for gas operated assemblies, where such approvals of listings have been established for the type of device offered and furnished. Further, all items furnished shall meet all requirements of the Occupational Safety and Health Act (OSHA), and state and federal requirements relating to clean air and water pollution.

- 10. <u>PATENT</u>: The Offeror shall hold and save Onslow County, its officers, agents, and employees, harmless from liability of any kind, including costs and expenses, on account of any copyrighted material, patented or unpatented invention, articles, device or appliance manufactured or used in the performance of this contract, including use by the government.
- 11. <u>INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR</u>: The Offeror shall be considered to be an independent contractor and as such shall be wholly responsible for the work to be performed and for the supervision of its employees. The Offerror represents that it has, or will secure at its own expense, all personnel required in performing the services under this agreement. Such employees shall not be employees of or have any individual contractual relationship with the County.

- 12. <u>SUBCONTRACTING</u>: Work proposed to be performed under this contract by the Offeror or its employees shall not be subcontracted without prior written approval of the County's Purchasing Division Head. Acceptance of an offeror's proposal shall include any subcontractor(s) specified therein.
- **13. PERFORMANCE AND DEFAULT:** If, through any cause, the Offeror shall fail to fulfill in timely and proper manner the obligations under this agreement, the County shall thereupon have the right to terminate this contract by giving written notice to the Offeror and specifying the effective date thereof. In that event, all finished or unfinished deliverable items under this contract prepared by the Offeror shall, at the option of the County, become its property, and the Offeror shall be entitled to receive just and equitable compensation for any satisfactory work completed on such materials. Notwithstanding, the Offeror shall not be relieved of liability to the County for damages sustained by the County by virtue of any breach of this agreement, and the County may withhold any payment due the Offeror for the purpose of setoff until such time as the exact amount of damages due the County from such breach can be determined.

In case of default by the Offeror, Onslow County may procure the services from other sources and hold the Offeror responsible for any excess cost occasioned thereby.

Upon the entering of a judgment of bankruptcy of insolvency by or against the Offeror, the County may terminate this contract for cause.

Neither party shall be deemed to be in default of its obligations hereunder if and so long as it is prevented from performing such obligations by any act of war, hostile foreign action, nuclear explosion, riot, strikes, civil insurrection, earthquake, hurricane, tornado, or other catastrophic natural event or act of God.

- 14. <u>CARE OF PROPERTY</u>: The Offeror agrees that it shall be responsible for the proper custody and care of any property furnished for use in connection with the performance of this contract or purchased by it for this contract and will reimburse Onslow County for loss of damage of such property.
- 15. <u>COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS</u>: The Offeror shall comply with all laws, ordinances, codes, rules, regulations, and licensing requirements that are applicable to the conduct of its business, including those of federal, state, and local agencies having jurisdiction and/or authority.
- 16. <u>ADVERTISING</u>: Offeror agrees not to use the existence of this contract or the name of Onslow County as a part of any commercial advertising without prior approval of Onslow County.
- 17. <u>INSURANCE</u>: During the term of the Contract, the Offeror at its sole cost and expense shall provide commercial insurance of such type and with such terms and limits as may be reasonably associated with the contract. As a minimum, the Offeror shall provide and maintain the following coverage and limits.
 - a. <u>Worker's Compensation</u> The Offeror shall provide and maintain worker's compensation insurance, as required by the laws of North Carolina, as well as employer's liability coverage with minimum limits of \$150,000, covering all of Offeror's employees who are engaged in any work under the contract. If any work is sublet, the Offeror shall require the subcontractor to provide the same coverage for any of his employees engaged in any work under the contract.
 - **b.** <u>**Commercial General Liability**</u> General Liability Coverage, on a Comprehensive Broad Form on an occurrence basis in the minimum amount of \$500,000.00 combined single limit (Defense cost shall be in excess of the limit of liability).
 - c. <u>Automobile</u> Automobile Liability Insurance, to include liability coverage, covering all owned, hired, and non-owned vehicles used in connection with the contract. The minimum combined single limit shall be \$150,000.00 bodily injury and property damage; \$150,000.00 uninsured/under-insured motorist; and \$1,000.00 medical payment.

- 18. <u>REQUIREMENTS</u>: Providing and maintaining adequate insurance coverage is a material obligation of the Offeror and is of the essence of this contract. All such insurance shall meet all laws of the state of North Carolina. Such insurance coverage shall be obtained from companies that are authorized to provide such coverage and that are authorized by the Commissioner of Insurance to do business in North Carolina. The Offeror shall at all times comply with the terms of such insurance policies, and all requirements of the insurer under any of such insurance policies, except as they may conflict with existing North Carolina laws or this contract. The limits of coverage under each insurance policy maintained by the Offeror shall not be interpreted as limiting the Offeror's liability and obligations under the contract.
- **19.** <u>ADMINISTRATIVE CODE</u>: Bids, proposals, and awards are subject to applicable provisions of the North Carolina Administrative Code.
- 20. <u>IRAN DIVESTMENT ACT</u>. Offeror certifies that they are not listed on the Final Divestment List created by the State Treasurer pursuant to N.C.G.S. 143-6A-4. Individuals or companies on the Final Divestment List are ineligible to contract or subcontract with Local Government Units. (G.S. 143C-6A-6(a).) It is the responsibility of each vendor or contractor to monitor compliance with this restriction. Contracts valued at less than \$1,000.00 are exempt from this restriction.
- 21. <u>DIVESTMENT FROM COMPANIES THAT BOYCOTT ISRAEL</u>.
