It is crucial to understand that Distech controls function at the equipment level, not at the building management level. As a result, there are minimal maintenance and service activities required for these controllers. Could you kindly confirm your awareness of this distinction and whether you intend to uphold this requirement without exceptions?	Equipment level is very critical at our Facility and this is a service contract. The ability to work on and program the Distech controls and Niagara is a requirement. There is no exception.

The scope is to include labor and materials needed to make repairs on the covered equipment. Example: a fan motor goes out on one of our Leibert cooling units. The motor would be covered. We would not expect the vendor to continue to sink money into an old piece of equipment after a reasonable effort to make repairs. Replacement of a piece of equipment that is beyond repair is not required either.
