# **Background**

Codrington Park is owned and managed by the City of Dunn. The primary users of the park live in adjacent neighborhoods, Police Athletic League and nearby daycare members. Existing facilities in the park include playground equipment, outdoor swimming pool facility, walking trail and multipurpose field.

# **Scope of Services**

The City of Dunn is requesting proposals that include the demolition and removal of the existing basketball courts and the installation of basketball court foundation. Bidders are encouraged to use existing asphalt for crushed based material for the new court. The dimensions of the total surface should be 110 feet long by 120 feet wide.

# **SITE PREPARATION:**

- Underground utilities shall be located and marked by Owner or others.
- Existing fence and basketball goals are to be removed and disposed of by others prior to mobilizing on the project.
- The awarded contractor to remove remaining concrete post footings and haul away.
- The awarded contractor to pulverize asphalt and blend with base.
- The awarded contractor shall verify that the existing slope at the courts is a minimum of .83

#### **RECONSTRUCTION:**

- Contractor shall survey and stake subgrade. Existing corner locations to remain.
- Contractor shall fine grade subgrade as necessary.
- Contractor to add 1/2" of ABC stone, and laser grade and compact stone base. Stone shall extend approximately 12" beyond edge of asphalt.
- Contractor to install and compact hot-mix asphalt, Type RS9.5B, to a compacted thickness of 3" in two (2) − 1 ½" lifts.
- After asphalt has cured a minimum of thirty (30) days, patch depressions/birdbaths holding more than 1/16"

The equipment should be in full compliance with both American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) and Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) guidelines. The equipment shall be accessible to the handicapped in accordance with State and Federal laws. Each proposal shall include the total cost for installing the equipment and surface. The successful bidder shall provide all insurance necessary for the installation portion of this project.

The successful proposer will assume all contract responsibilities within his/her agreement with the City of Dunn. # **Format for Proposals**

Proposers are encouraged to be concise and proposals must include, but are not limited to, the following:

- a) Letter of transmittal and completed BID SHEET;
- b) A detailed listing of all equipment proposed with cut sheets providing all specifications
- Detailed description of the provisions provided for handicapped accessibility, compliance with ASTM and CPSC guidelines should be specified;
- d) Full description of the extent of the product warranty provided for all equipment;
- e) Installation schedule;
- f) Qualifications of key personnel proposed to be assigned to this job;
- g) Location of the office from which the management of this project will be performed;
- h) A listing of at least two sites, preferably nearby, with comparable equipment, and a name and
- i) phone number of a contact person for each site.
