Pursuant to Section 143-131 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, informal bids are solicited and will be received via email directly to [sunderwood@cumberlandcountync.gov](mailto:sunderwood@cumberlandcountync.gov) or by mail to the following address: 130 Gillespie St, Fayetteville, NC 28301 at any time before **10:00 AM** on **December 4, 2025** per the clock in the Engineering office.

A **MANDATORY** pre-bid meeting will be held on-site at 1225 Ramsey Street, Fayetteville, NC 28301 at **10:30 AM** on **November 25, 2025**. Vendors shall meet at the main reception information desk of the lobby of the Department of Social Services building. All questions shall be submitted in writing to [sunderwood@cumberlandcountync.gov](mailto:sunderwood@cumberlandcountync.gov) by **5:00 PM** on **December 1, 2025**. This will provide ample time to issue an addendum for this project if necessary.

Instructions: Vendors invited to submit bids are required to have a representative present at the pre-bid meeting and appraise themselves of the conditions and requirements which will affect the performance of the work called for by this invitation for bid. This is a **MANDATORY** pre-bid meeting. Therefore, bids will not be accepted from any vendor who is not present for the pre-bid meeting.

Vendor is cautioned that any information released to attendees during the site visit, other than that involving the physical aspects of the facility referenced above, and which conflicts with, supersedes, or adds to requirements in this invitation for bid, must be confirmed by written addendum before it can be considered to be a part of this proposal.

Bidder shall identify on the bid, the minority businesses that will be utilized on the project with corresponding total dollar value of the bid and affidavit listing good faith efforts or an affidavit indicating work under Contract will be self-performed, as required by G.S. 143-128.2(c) and G.S. 143-128.2(f). Failure to comply with these requirements is grounds for rejection of the bid.

All Contractors are notified that North Carolina Statutory provisions as to licensing for Contractors will be observed in receiving, reading, and awarding of contracts. ~~All bidders that submit a proposal for this project must be a North Carolina Licensed General Contractor.~~

It is the responsibility of the Contractor to verify all measurements and quantities.

The County reserves the right to reject any or all proposals.

The bidder to whom the contract may be awarded must comply with the requirements of G.S. Section 143-131, as amended.

No bids may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of proposals for a period of forty-five (45) days.

**Contractors are hereby notified that they must have proper license under the State laws governing their respective trades and that North Carolina General Statutes 87 will be observed in receiving and awarding contracts.**

**Contractor must be located within 200 miles of DSS facility to ensure repairs/warranty calls can be handled in a timely manner.**
