

2	General	Will common areas be clear of furniture and other items before work begins, or will it be moved by the ncsu team on an as needed basis?	The owner will need to know the schedule of the dates and areas the work will take place, to coordinate the moving of the furniture.		
3	General	Will there be coordination with campus security if working in the building after hours?	The owner will notify campus security a contractor will be working in the building. The awarded contractor will be issued an ID badge (NC State Wolfpack One Card).will be required for the sit contact and encouraged for all team members. Talley Student Union will pay for up to 2 cards if needed. Any additional cards the contractor will be responsible for purchasing.		
4	General	Is there a preferred method for reporting progress or any unexpected issues encountered during the project?	You are to contact the owner immediately if there are any issues. The owner will let the awarded contractor know how to contact them via phone, text or email. Daily coordination (completion prior expected work area for the day and the next day or two's projected work) and reporting will be key to success for inspection, moving furniture and safety.		
5	General	Will any other work be done in the building and areas during the installation time frame? How will the coordination between the contractors be handled?	The staff will work to reduce other work and overall traffic around the areas of active carpet installation. Coordination of expected work areas is key.		
6	General	Can the bid contract be signed through an e- signature?	Signing a contract is not required. The bidder will need to sign the bid document. The awarded bidder will receive a NC State PO which stands as an official contract between NC State University and the name of the vendor noted on the document.

8	General	What is meant in regards to Floor 3 that the carpet transition is to align with the expansonjoing?	On floor 3 at the North and South entrance theater doors. The new carpet to be installed under the doorways and installed in the expansion joint. All carpet installed in any expansion joints in the building are to follow the same installation carpet pattern alignment as the carpet being installed next to the expansion joint.






Third Floor Location For Stair Nosing
