Project Overview – This project will involve expanding the current recycling center facility to the south, construction of a noise retaining wall and noise berm, evergreen screening, canopy structure, stormwater design with dry detention pond, new asphalt and concrete pavement, concrete compactor pads, power service to the canopy area (including the powering of two kiosks and household hazardous waste building), additional site lighting, extension of a water main and the addition of a new fire hydrant near the site front entrance area.

This project is anticipated to have approximately 2,400 cubic yards of excess cut material. Clean cut material is to please be stockpiled on-site for use in a future project.

Per the Bid Drawings, the Contractor may haul any demolition materials to the Foxhole Landfill and this material will be accepted free of charge. The Contractor shall be responsible for associated transportation of this demolition material. Additionally, the Contractor is to please consider grinding demolished asphalt for reuse on the site.

Work Hours (Mon-Fri: 7:00 am to 4:00 pm, Sat: 7:00 am to 4:00 pm) or as agreed – *This can be subject to change and will be determined at construction Notice to Proceed.* 

Site Access – Construction site access will be through the site main site entrance/exit along Statesville Road. The recycling center is to remain open throughout the entire construction project. The need for Traffic Control can be determined at a later date during project progression. Contractor personnel shall follow speed limits and proper traffic flow. Maintaining safety of personnel and users of the recycling center is of the utmost importance.

BDI Program – John Walton (Mecklenburg County) discussed the County's Business Diversity & Inclusion (BDI) Program requirements. The Subcontractor (not Prime Contractor) participation goals for this project are 10% Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) and 2% Women Business Enterprise (WBE). As discussed, please keep documentation of your Good Faith Efforts (GFE) towards achieving the goal of fifty (50) points. It is recommended that these efforts not be delayed until the last minute.
