Pursuant to the General Statutes of North Carolina, Section 143-128 et. seq, contractors are invited to submit Single Prime Construction bids providing labor, material, and equipment for entering into a Single Prime Contract. The scope of work includes but is not limited to the following:

- Removal and replacement of approximately 16 LF of damaged 60" Diameter reinforced concrete pipe (RCP)
- Installation of concrete collar between existing and replaced pipe and mortar grouting of internal joint
- Temporary bypass pumping
- Filling, grading, seeding, cleaning and restoring all disturbed areas including but not limited to asphalt and concrete pavement restoration
- Traffic control Plan and ROW permits

Paper hard copy sealed bids are not required and digital submissions are allowed. Bidders have three (3) options for delivery of their bid documents:

- Digital submittal to kinley.rojzman@raleighnc.gov prior to 3:00 pm on bid day.
- Mail in bids in accordance with the address shown above.
- Early delivery via in person/hand delivery on the day of the bid opening during the time shown above. The City's Stormwater Division project manager will be onsite at that time to receive bids. Envelopes must be addressed and sealed and will be securely held until the time of the bid opening later that afternoon.

No public opening will be held in accordance with informal bidding rules.

Partial sets of plans and specifications will not be issued. Contractors are responsible for distributing documents to all sub-contractors.

Information related to this solicitation, including any addenda, will be posted to the Interactive Purchasing System (<https://ips.state.nc.us>).

Bidders will be required to show evidence that they are licensed to perform the work in the Bidding Documents as required by North Carolina General Statute, Chapter 87.

Pursuant to North Carolina General Statutes §143-128.2 et seq. and §143-131, and in accordance with City policy, the City of Raleigh encourages and provides equal opportunity for certified Minority and Women-Owned Business Enterprise (MWBE) businesses to participate in all aspects of the City's contracting and procurement programs to include: Professional Services, Goods and Other Services, and Construction. The prime contractor will be required to identify participation of MWBE businesses in their proposal and demonstrate how that participation will be achieved.

The City's goal is to contract and sub-contract fifteen percent (15%) of the total contract amount to Certified MWBEs on construction projects of \$300,000 or more, or contracts of \$100,000 or more that include any State funding.

No Bid may be withdrawn for Forty-Five (45) days after opening time.

The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive informalities.
