## **ADDENDUM 1 – Questions and Answers**

- Q1. Please confirm the number of central warehouses and central kitchens in use.
- A1. As of August 2024, DPS will have one central warehouse and one catering production in use; additionally there will be 49 school-based kitchens.
- Q2. Is truck routing and bin/slot management utilized in warehouse or central kitchen locations?
- A2. At this time, we do not use truck routing or bin/slot management software at the warehouse or central catering production kitchen.
- Q3. What is the anticipated Award Date?
- A3. No later than May 17, 2024
- Q4. What is the anticipated project start date and go-live date?
- A4. Start date: June 1, 2024; go-live date for all components January 6, 2025 HOWEVER, the nutrition planning software is a priority and we'll go live with that as soon as possible.
- Q5. What is your district's estimated meals online payment volume?
- A5. This is a wild guess currently. Our target is 500 adults and 1000 high school students per day; we will not achieve these numbers on Day 1.
- Q6. How many ingredients, recipes, and menus does Durham Public Schools have?

- A6. We are starting over with our ingredients, recipes, and menus. We anticipate a four week, three season (Fall, Winter, Spring) and two week, one season (Summer) menu. With four school meal types (preK, k-5, 6-8, and 9-12) plus adult meals, and two entrees, two fruits, two vegetables, at most meals plus SmartSnack a la carte options, we estimate roughly 400 recipes with supporting ingredients.
- Q7. What type of training is preferred, Train the Trainer, or Turnkey?
- A7. Please provide pricing and description of both options if available.
- Q8. Does Durham Public Schools have year-round schools, or track scheduling?
- A8. Yes, in SY24-25 DPS has 9 year round elementary schools and two year round middle schools.
- Q9. What is the district's current Student Information System?
- A9. PowerSchool, moving to Infinite Campus within the next year.
- Q10. What is the district's current Financial/Accounting System?
- A10. Sylogist, plus some residual offerings in SunPac/AS400.
- Q11. What is the number of serving lines?
- A11. 89
- Q12. What is the number of sites/buildings?
- A12. 55
- Q13. How many applications do you process annually?
- A13. 0. We are districtwide CEP in SY24-25.
- Q14. How many POS terminals are in use?
- A14. 85
- Q15. If demos are required, what dates will they be held?
- A15. June/July/August 2024
- Q16. In regard to Section 6. Proposal, RFP pages 12 and 13. Can you clarify the meaning of "supply chain hierarchy" and "order hierarchy," for the following requirements:

- Central Purchasing: Automatically transform requisitions to purchase orders and supply orders based on supply chain hierarchy
  - "Supply chain hierarchy" suggests that if there is USDA product in the warehouse, use that item first; if there is no USDA product in the warehouse, then allow purchase from broadline distributor
- Inventory: Easily set an order hierarchy for each inventory item
  - Same ideas as supply chain hierarchy above
