Questions and Answers:

1. Who is the manufacturer required for fume arms?

- **Answer:** The design basis is IAP Air products but similar articulating welding fume arms by other manufacturer are acceptable.
- 2. Who is responsible for natural gas lines? The gas company or would the GC sub that out?
- **Answer:** The GC will extend the existing gas line.
- **3.** For Alternate #1, which windows will fall under the alternate or base bid? The alternate states "new double pane operable windows" and the manual states all storefront will be Alternate #1 since these are not the same can we get a clarification on which windows will be priced as an alternate or what type of windows the project needs?
- **Answer:** All the window replacement effort should be priced as Alternate #1. Follow the basis of design for a single paned storefront and the specification section for the window requirements. The Alternate #1 wording has been revised in this Addendum #3.
- **4.** Plan M1.1 shows an existing chain link fence on one side of the building. Does the GC supply a temporary perimeter chain link fence on the other 3 sides during construction to create a perimeter zone / barrier as defined in the bid documents?
- **Answer:** The GC will provide the perimeter fencing.

Agenda:

1. Review Project Scope

- A. The scope of this project will be to provide ventilation, heating, and cooling to keep the building in the 65 F to 80 F range during the year.
- B. A new electrical service will be required to accommodate the new HVAC equipment.
- C. Owner desires to replace the existing windows with new double pane operable windows, which will be Alternate #1.
- D. For alternate #2: The existing Federal Pacific panelboard will be replaced with a new panelboard. A new feeder will be required. This work is mandatory, but it will be priced as an alternate.
- E. Bids will be received as a single prime contract
- F. The proposal will be a lump sum proposal

2. Questions

- A. We cannot provide responses to specific questions at this time by state bidding procedure. Any and all questions will be documented and responded to by Addenda.
- B. The last day for questions will be Wednesday, December 4, 2024, NOON so we can respond to them via Addendum, no later than 7 days before bid opening.

3. Project Schedule

- A. Schedule for contract time of completion is currently 120 days from the NTP. NTP is expected to occur around Mid-January, 2025, but not guaranteed
- B. Contractor shall be permitted to work 7:30 am to 5pm Mondays through Fridays.
 C. Prior approval is required from Cleveland Community College and security to

- D. There will be an establishment of a work zone perimeter around the facility involving the construction. Contractor and its employees must always remain within the designated work area.

1.1 SUMMARY

1.2 DEFINITIONS

- A. Alternate: An amount proposed by bidders and stated on the Bid Form for certain work defined in the bidding requirements that may be added to or deducted from the base bid amount if the Owner decides to accept a corresponding change either in the amount of construction to be completed or in the products, materials, equipment, systems, or installation methods described in the Contract Documents.
 - 1. Alternates described in this Section are part of the Work only if enumerated in the Agreement.
 - 2. The cost or credit for each alternate is the net addition to or deduction from the Contract Sum to incorporate alternates into the Work. No other adjustments are made to the Contract Sum.

1.3 PROCEDURES

- A. Coordination: Revise or adjust affected adjacent work as necessary to completely integrate work of the alternate into Project.
 - 1. Include as part of each alternate, miscellaneous devices, accessory objects, and similar items incidental to or required for a complete installation whether or not indicated as part of alternate.
- B. Execute accepted alternates under the same conditions as other work of the Contract.
- C. Schedule: A schedule of alternates is included at the end of this Section. Specification Sections referenced in schedule contain requirements for materials necessary to achieve the work described under each alternate.
