Pursuant to N.C.G.S. 143-128 and 143-129 and city policy, sealed proposals endorsed “**Business 40 Corridor Enhancements, FB2625**” will be received by City/County Purchasing, City Hall, 101 North Main Street, Winston-Salem, NC until the date and time listed above. The City reserves the right to reject any or all proposals. Should less than three bids be received, the project will have to be re-advertised.

Bidders must be properly licensed as required by Chapter 87 of the North Carolina General Statutes. 100% Performance & Payment Bonds will be required of the awarded contractor.

Bidders are encouraged to carefully read and understand the contents of the Bidding Documents. The bid documents include the bid package, plans, and the specifications on the plan sheets. This project includes site and lighting improvements along Business 40 at eight (8) separate locations. Trades include electrical, concrete, wood fencing (decorative), landscape work, and some site demolition. Certain light fixtures are already purchased by the city but will require transportation from their storage location to the work locations.

The M/WBE subcontracting goals for this project are **8% MBE** and **5% WBE** and must be met separately.
