THAT: It is the intention of the Owner to let contracts on the basis of the Bids received in accordance with G.S. 143-129 and in such manner as the Owner may deem to be for the best interests of the Owner.

THAT: The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all proposals.

THAT: The work under each Section will be awarded under one Contract and that the Owner shall have the right to include such item or items as the Owner may deem to be in the best interests of the Owner.

THAT: On being awarded the Contract, the Bidder shall execute a Performance Bond and a Payment Bond, on the forms included herein, each equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract Price (Contract Sum), as security for the faithful performance of the Contract.

THAT: The Bidder shall submit, in the blank spaces provided, all data, guarantees and other information called for.

THAT: This Proposal shall be signed and submitted in the manner prescribed in the Instructions to Bidders.

THAT: Should this Proposal not be accepted by the Owner, the certified check, in the amount of:

THAT: The successful bidder shall be required to submit a complete detailed cost breakdown of the Lump Sum Bid Price amount (if project is a lump sum bid) for payment purposes, for approval by the Engineer, prior to the Award of the Contract.

THAT: It is the intent of these Contract Documents to obtain a Contract based on a Lump Sum Price except where Unit Prices are specifically requested. Where a discrepancy exists between words and numbers in the Bid amount, the written words shall govern. Where a discrepancy exists between unit prices and mathematical computations in the Itemized Proposal, the unit prices and quantities in the Itemized Proposal shall govern.

THAT: The successful bidder shall have all proper Bidder licenses and other applicable licenses required under North Carolina state laws governing their respective trade(s).

THAT: The successful bidder and all subcontractors shall comply with the requirements of Article 2 of Chapter 64 of the North Carolina General Statutes, "Verification of Work Authorization," and shall provide documentation or sign affidavits or any other documents requested by the Town of Cary demonstrating such compliance.

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC CONTROL

Description

Contractor to install temporary traffic control on the trail as shown in the Pedestrian Closure plans. Contractor to coordinate with the Owner and Engineer during transitions of phases to ensure adequate pedestrian access and safety are maintained for the duration of the project. Detour signs shall be paid for under the standard *Work Zone Sign (Stationary)* found in the Standard Specifications.

Materials

Refer to Division 10.

Greenway Barricades shall be provided and installed by the contractor. See notes on sheet PC-1 of the planset for additional information on mounting hardware and post type required.

Contractor shall be responsible for providing posts and mounting hardware for all signs and barricades.

Submittals

Contractor shall notify in writing to the Owner and Engineer no less than 10 days prior to completion of each phase of work. The notification shall include anticipated date of completion for each phase of pedestrian closure and as per any relevant requirements in the ICTs. Any changes in the date of completion shall be communicated as soon as possible after the initial notification.

Construction Methods

For each phase of construction:

- A. Verify location of required detour signs and information signs per the greenway detour plan with the Owner. Verify location of barricades with Owner and the Pedestrian Closure plans.
- B. Remove old detour and information signs as required and re-install them in the approved locations. Excess signs shall be stockpiled and protected for future use.
- C. Relocate Barricades as required to maintain construction access and public safety. At the completion of the project, all detour signs, information signs, and all posts and hardware shall be removed from site and site conditions shall be restored.

Measurement and Payment

Temporary Traffic Control shall include all labor, equipment, and materials to complete all phases of the pedestrian closures and detours. All barricades, mountings, posts, and hardware shall be incidental to the Temporary Traffic Control.

Fifty percent of the contract lump sum price bid will be paid on the first monthly estimate and the remaining fifty percent will be paid each subsequent estimate based on the percent of the project completed
