ADDENDUM NO. 2

The purpose of this addendum is to answer questions submitted.

- 1) **QUESTION:** Not sure of the difference between unit price and extended price. My assumption is the unit price is the individual selling price and the extended price is the price with all taxes and fees included.
ANSWER: The unit price is for the total cost of the vehicle including any and all fees. The extended price is the unit price times the number of vehicles. The unit price is the only amount that will be awarded and put on the purchase order. No other amount should be invoiced nor will it be paid.

- 2) **QUESTION:** On page 1 at the bottom of the page it mentions payment terms. Is the net referring to 1 unit or all 6 units combined. And does this number include all fees(tax/ tag/etc) or just the selling price before fees.
ANSWER: The City of Asheville's payment terms are Net 30 for any invoice whether it has one or 6 vehicles on it.. The City of Asheville pays the tax, tag, and title after the vehicle is received. The vendor's invoice should not have any taxes listed. The unit price is the only amount that will be paid.
