Questions/Answers

1. For the Tactical Robot your team is looking for, would your team only want to purchase the robot and handle repairs internally?

Yes, the County will handle the robot purchase and the team will handle any repairs as necessary.

2. As we reviewed the bid's mandatory specifications, we noted a requirement for a Carbon Firing system on the robot—a feature we hadn't previously discussed. We also observed other "required" items, such as a two-year warranty.

Could you please confirm whether these are firm requirements for this solicitation? If so, would you prefer that we withhold our bid, or should we submit it and clearly indicate any specifications we cannot meet?

Additionally, could you clarify whether you intend to procure a single robot for both the bomb unit and the SWAT team, or two separate robots—one of which would be our platform for Lt. Fermin's project (separate from this bid)?

To be competitive, the bid, if submitted should contain the preferred listed specifications. I cannot advise if your company should or should not submit a bid. This IFB request is solely for the purchase of a robot overseen by and for Bomb Squad use and is not related in any way to the SWAT team's robot project.
