Sealed Bids will be received until 2:00 PM, Tuesday, July 14, 2026 at One Exchange Plaza, Suite 620, Raleigh, NC 27601 at which time and place bids will be publicly opened and read aloud for the construction of the Crabtree Interceptor Phase III Improvements project.

After Bids are opened, the Owner shall evaluate them in accordance with the methods and criteria set forth in the Bid Proposal Form. The Owner/City Council reserves the right to waive any informality or to reject any or all Bids. Unless all Bids are rejected, Award will be made to the lowest responsible and responsive Bidder, taking into consideration quality, performance and the time specified in the Bid Form for the performance of the Contract.

A Non-Mandatory and virtual Pre-Bid Meeting will be held at 10:00 AM, Tuesday, June 16, 2026. Only prequalified contractors and tunnel contractors will be allowed to participate and bid and are encouraged to attend. The Project consists generally of the following major items:

Installation of approximately 21,600 linear feet of 8-inch to 54-inch gravity sanitary sewer, abandonment of existing sanitary sewer, and replacement of existing water main.

Bidders will be required to show evidence that they are licensed to perform the work in the Bidding Documents as required by North Carolina General Statute, Chapter 87 and the Instruction to Bidders.
